

## TROOP 307 CHECK LIST FOR SUMMER CAMP

**WHAT TO LEAVE HOME**

Fixed blade knives

Radios/tape players/MP3 players/iPods/iPads/electronic games (must be left in vehicles if brought to camp)

Firearms and ammunition (anything that shoots a projectile)

Bicycles

Open-toed shoes

Cell phones (must be left in vehicles if brought to camp. There is no cell phone coverage at Camp Rainey Mt)
